- Provide focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against the year-level achievement standards in literacy and numeracy.
- Provide human and teaching resources to enhance the teaching of literacy and numeracy:
  - increase the percentage of students able to successfully read and comprehend texts and compose written texts to meet Regional standards.
  - increase the percentage of Prep students able to read and comprehend short, predictable texts and compose and record short, meaningful sentences to 100% at the reporting level of 'Working With' or better.

- Implementing goal-setting for reading and writing.


## Our school will improve student outcomes by
